What percentage of practicing psychologists specialize in clinical or counseling psychology? About 70% of psychologists specialize in clinical and counseling.

What does this tell you about the practice of psychology? The data shows that if you are in the practice of psychology, and it tends to be in the clinical and counseling fields.

Describe the different functions of the clinical care of the brain consequent to the medical model. Why are both important? The medical care of the brain helps regulate basic life processes such as breathing, pulse, general movement, behavior, sleep, and the early stages of processing sensory information. As opposed to the medical care, [the medical care] supports functions including memory, thoughts, perceptual processes, language, language, and communication.
