Simple	<p>S + V2 + O</p> <p>I ate burger yesterday.</p>	<p>S + V1 + O</p> <p>I eat burger yesterday.</p>	<p>S + will + V + O</p> <p>I will eat burger tomorrow</p>
Continuous	<p>S + was/were (V+ing) + O</p> <p>I was eating burger when you arrived.</p>	<p>S + am/is/are + (V+ing) + O</p> <p>I am eating burger right now.</p>	<p>S + will be + (V+ing) + O</p> <p>I will be eating burger when you arrive.</p>
Perfect	<p>S + had + V3 + O</p> <p>I had eaten all of the burger when you arrived.</p>	<p>S + have/has + V3 + O</p> <p>I have eaten all of the burger.</p>	<p>S + will have + V3 + O</p> <p>I will have eaten all of the burger by the time you arrive.</p>
Perfect Continuous	<p>S + had been + (V+ing) + O</p> <p>I had been eating burger for 2 hours when you arrived.</p>	<p>S + have/has been + (V+ing) + O</p> <p>I have been eating burger for 2 hours.</p>	<p>S + will have been + (V+ing) + O</p> <p>I will have been eating burger for 2 hours when you arrive.</p>
