Which comments in the table are correct? Which are incorrect?

When the first vowel in the spelling of a verb is *voiced*, the 'ed' sounds like /d/
When the first vowel of a verb is *voiceless*, the 'ed' sounds like /t/.

When a verb ends in *voiced* /d/ or /t/, the 'ed' sounds like /əd/ and it always follows
/ə/.

Put the following regular past tense verbs into the correct column:

called answered asked asked stopped started arrived visited painted
kissed returned looked worked opened pulled pushed played
called went arrived
