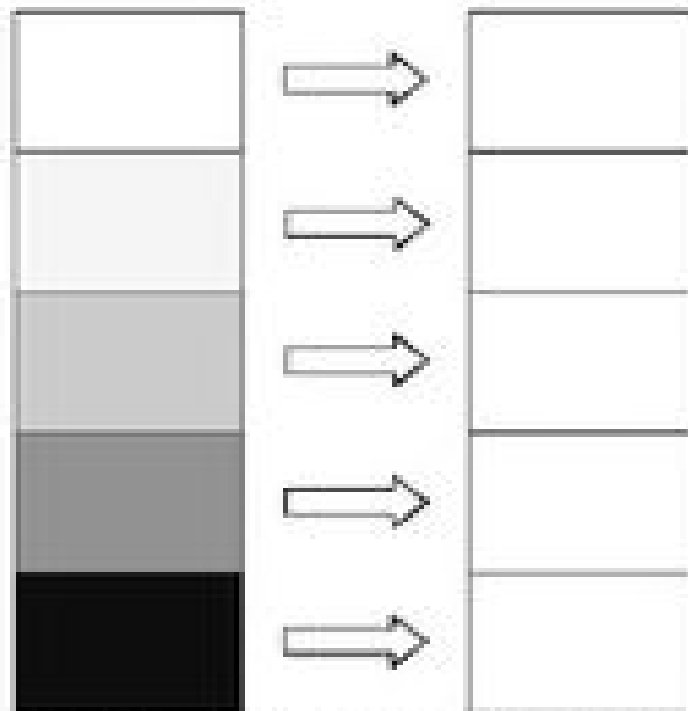


Using **VALUE** in Drawing

When artists use **value**, they are using a **variety of shades**. This helps their artwork look more realistic, gives the composition more dimension, and appeals to the viewer's eye.



Above is an example of a value scale—it shows **graded** value, from white, light gray, medium gray, and dark gray, to black. Using **pressure** to change the value tones, fill in the blank set of value scales to use as a reference for your artwork.
