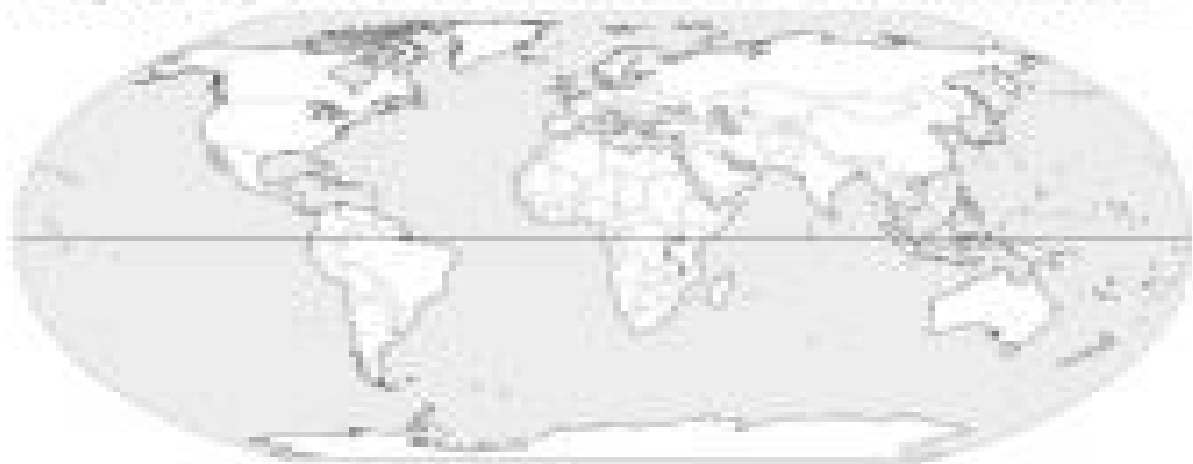


From 1960, the **Great Lakes** flow to the sea via the **St. Lawrence** (2000 km) to the **Atlantic Ocean**. The **St. Lawrence** is about 70% water and 30% land. The land is divided (2000 km) into 7 **countries**: **USA, Canada, North America, South America, Europe, Antarctica, and Australia**. The water is divided into 4 **basins**: the **Pacific Ocean**, the **Atlantic Ocean**, the **Indian Ocean**, and the **Arctic Ocean**. The **Equator** is a imaginary line that divides the earth in half. It separates **North America** from **South America**.
