

6.4 Demonstrative adjectives and pronouns

- In Spanish, as in English, demonstrative adjectives are words that “demonstrate” or “point out” nouns.
- Demonstrative adjectives precede the nouns they modify and, like other Spanish adjectives you have studied, agree with them in gender and number. Observe these, then study the chart that follows:

esta camisa

this shirt

ese vendedor

that salesman

aquellos zapatos

those shoes (over there)
