Words that end with -e, take off the -e before adding -y.

grease	laze	haze	bone	smoke

Words that end with a short vowel and a consonant, double the final consonant before adding -y. (except words which end with -x)

fun	run	fat	sun	nut

Most other words, just add -y.

wind	crisp	mess	dirt	thirst
