

Individual Food and Kitchen Safety Activities

From the following activities select TWO to complete and pass in. Select one of the two completed activities to present to the class (3-5 minute presentation)

- A. Draw your own version of "What's wrong with this picture". You must have at least 10 food and kitchen safety hazards. Below your drawing, or on another piece of paper, list all the hazards that you have shown.
- B. Create a tri-fold Kitchen Safety Brochure. Make sure you use both writing and illustrations. You may use your notes or the textbooks for ideas.
- C. Make a children's book (for 5-6 year olds) of at least 6 pages about kitchen safety. Keep in mind that this age group likes pictures and very easy words.
- D. Food Safety Poster – Using the 4 Fight BAC safety rules, create a safety poster. You may use the textbooks if you need ideas. Should include a slogan and illustrations.
- E. Food Safety Board Game – Create a board game with trivia, rules and a game board. You could also create an electronic game if you wish.
- F. Activity of your choice. This must be discussed with me prior to starting. Suggestions are welcome.

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
