#### Written Assignments

Each night that reading is required on the calendar, students must complete either a sticky note activity or one of the choices from the Tic-Tac-Toe board.

Choose at least two "Sticky Note Topics" to record on a sticky note for discussion with your book club:

- oWhat is a question you have about what you read?
- oAre there any new words you found? What do you think they mean?
- oAfter reading your assigned pages, predict what you think will happen next.
- oWhat is your opinion about a topic from the assigned pages?
- oHow were you connected to the reading selection? Does it remind you of
- something from your life or a book you have read before?
- oDo you have a favorite part from this reading? What was it and why?

- oDid everyone complete the assignment?
- oTake turns reviewing responses of the group. Discuss each part of the assignment in depth, looking back at the book as necessary.
- Each group member completes a brief "Day of Discussion Notes" from the handout to summarize what was discussed.
