volar → **vuela** → drop "e" → **vuela = volar**

comer the food → **comer** to eat → **comer** to eat → **Comer**
 the word gets an accent mark on the second syllable and the "e" is not

volar the verb → **volar** to fly → **volar** to fly → **Volar**
 the word gets an accent mark on the second syllable and the "e" is not

hablar the verb → **hablar** to speak → **hablar** to speak → **hablar**
 the word gets an accent mark on the first syllable and the "e" is not
