To show an affixed morpheme in Spanish, we simply take the root form of a verb, and drop the "r".

Example: **hablar** → **habla** → drop "r" → **habla** = Spanish  
**comer** → **come** → drop "r" → **come** = Eat  
**volar** → **vola** → drop "r" → **vola** = Fly

When you add the first affix to the root, you have to add an accent mark. The number for syllables of the word, and mark the accent mark on the "r" in the last syllable.

**volar** the verb → **vola** to fly → **volar** to fly → **Volador**  
 the verb to fly to eat get an accent mark over the "o" in vol

**hablar** the verb → **habla** to speak → **hablar** to speak → **hablar**  
 the verb to speak get an accent mark over the "a" in hab
