To show an affixed compound in Spanish, we simply take the first form of a verb, and drop the "r".

Example: **hablar** → **habla** → drop "r" → **habla** + Spanish
comer → **come** → drop "r" → **come** + Spanish
volar → **vola** → drop "r" → **vola** + Spanish

 The word gets to start get an accent mark over the "r" in hab
