To show an affixed morpheme in Spanish, we simply take the root form of a verb, and drop the "r".

Example: **hablar** → **habla** → drop "r" → **habla** = Spanish  
**comer** → **come** → drop "r" → **come** = Eat  
**volar** → **vole** → drop "r" → **vole** = Fly
