To show an affixed compound in Spanish, we simply take the first form of a verb, and drop the "r".

Example: **hablar** → **habla** → **drop "r"** → **habla** + **Spanish**
comer → **come** → **drop "r"** → **come** + **Span**
volar → **vola** → **drop "r"** → **vola** + **Span**
