

returning soldiers

We are returning home and The Cross and tens of thousands of black men were drafted into a great struggle. For Standing France and what she means and her cause and will mean to us and humanity and against the forces of German war savagery, we fought gladly and in the last ship of blood; the Americas and her highest ideals, we fought in their own hope, for the dominion so others oligarchically entrenched in Washington, we fought in bitter struggle. For the Americas that represents and glorifies in lynching, discrimination, racism, brutality and冷笑ism itself—for this, in the brutal upturning and turning of things, we were forced by conditions that so fight also.

But today we return! We return from the slavery of warships which the world's masters demanded us to wear to the destruction of our part. We stand again to look America squarely in the face and call a grade a grade. We say: This country of ours, despite all its better souls have done and demanded, is yet a shameful land.

In lynches.

And lynching is perversion of a degree of non-combatant savagery unparalleled in human history. For 20 years we have bombed poor Negroes a week, and we have kept this day right through the war.

In destructions its own citizens.

Crusade-discrim (taking away the right to work) is the deliberate theft and robbery of the only protection of poor against rich and black, against white. The God that discriminates has not one god but many gods; a democracy lies and knows it lies.

In encouraging ignorance.

In law never study tried to educate the Negro. A Christian ministry does not want Negroes educated. It wants servants, dogs, whores and monkeys. And when this God allows a reactionary group by its unwise political power to force us master black folk into these categories as a people by law, it runs in contradictory hypocrisy: "They therefore will be educated" they cannot be educated!

In penal systems.

In organizations robbery to collect us. It takes us out of our land, it takes us out of our labor. It seizes our savings. It reduces our wages. It makes our rents. It steals our profits. It robs us without compensation. It keeps us constantly and universally poor, and then feeds us on charity and denies our poverty.

In insults us.

In law-organized a nation-wide and lonely a world-wide gang of soldiers and commoners (rich and defrauders of black, blood-thirsty slaves). In decree that it shall not be possible to leave our residence, work our place, education nor travel free for a black man to exist without fear or open acknowledgment of his inferiority to the chosen white dog. And in looks upon any negro to question or even discuss this dogma as strong and unswayed reasoning and reason.

This is the country in which we Soldiers-of-Democracy return. This is the nation in which we thought that it is our birthright. It was right then to fight. Under similar circumstances, we would fight again. But by the God of Heaven, we are cowards and jackasses of now than then we were, we do not demand every ounce of our blood and brains to fight a longer; more unending battle against the forces of hell in our own land.

We return.

We return from fighting.

We return fighting.

What way for Democracy? We saved it in France, and by the Great Sabbath, we will save it in the United States of America, or know the reason why.

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
