Scenario #1 M/W 85 minutes **T/Th/Fri 120 minutes**

		Small group support; peers help support each other
T, Th, Fri	30 minutes	Practice and Extend Groups (Trade students with partner teacher)
		Students select which group they want to go to depending on how they feel about the concepts being taught that week.
		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Extend Group- Kids who feel great about the standard; do problem solving and challenging activities; higher level algebra; used HM extend activities, Chapter Challenges book • Practice Group- Reteaching lessons; use Alternative Approach, Practice Problems in book, white boards, etc.

Scenario #2 90+ minutes

10-15minutes	Brain Boosters (These are activities that warm up the brain - such as logic and strategy puzzles.)
10 minutes	Correct homework (Kids share how many were missed on homework in order to put into groups for the day.)
20 minutes	Group kids based on homework. Peers help teach struggling students. Small group with teacher to review with kids who struggled with concepts from homework.
30 minutes	Guided lesson (Kids take notes in their math notebook) and guided practice
10-15 minutes	Independent Practice
