Students who struggle in math may take Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II at the regular level, but they will not qualify to take the IB Calculus SL or HL course or exams. Students who choose the regular path may still take the IB Math Studies SL course and exam. IB Math Studies is designed for students who do not consider math one of their strongest subjects. Parents, if you think the regular math path is best for your student, please scratch out H/Pre-AP/IH and the course number following the course name and write in REGULAR.

What about athletics, band, P.E., health, or speech, classes?

You, your parents, and your eighth-grade counselor will make decisions about your remaining classes during your Spring 2011 academic conference. (All other choices must fulfill PISD Graduation Requirements.)

Special IB 4 Year Plan?

IH students are not required to complete a four-year plan in the 8th grade. Instead, students will use this worksheet to guide them to the IH 9th grade course selections. Counselors at Clark or Williams will guide students to the IH recommended 10th grade course selections in the middle of the 9th grade. During the 10th grade year, students will complete a two-year plan and an IB Diploma Program plan.
