Value: the lightness to darkness of a hue.

Monochromatic Colors are all the colors (hue) and shades of a single hue.

• Tint is a hue (a color) + white added

• Shade is a hue (a color) + black added

• Shade is a hue (a color) + Black added

• Tint is a hue (a color) + white added

Blue	Blue + Blue + Black	Blue + Black gray proportions	Black + Black + Blue	Black
