


Topic: Map Reference

Lithonia Grid Refresher

1. Maps are divided into squares using parallel lines.
2. The vertical lines running from south to north are called **meridians** as their value increases towards the east.
3. The horizontal lines running from west to east are called **parallels** as their value increases towards the north.
4. The use of meridians and parallels is to create a reference point on a map. This is called the grid reference.
5. The first element stated in the grid reference is the **meriting** followed by the **paralleling**. E.g., Point A is found in grid 09-09. This is called the **Four Figure grid reference**.
6. To refer to a specific point in a grid the **six figure grid reference** is used. This is done by dividing the grid into 10 equal parts. E.g. Point A is found in grid reference 0909-090.
