
HOW TO MAKE A MINOR PENTATONIC BLUES SCALE

Just like a major or minor scale, the pentatonic blues scale is made up of specific intervals. Test your skills by filling in the charts below. **Hint**: When counting half-steps, remember that you *do not* count the original key—i.e. when finding a minor 3rd from C, do not count C as the first half step.
