Storage Method	Litter or compost is stored in a non-leaking stacking shed with a concrete floor. Stacks are protected from rainwater by a 6-mil plastic cover. Surface water is diverted around the stacks.	Litter or compost is routinely stacked at least 100 feet downslope from the well or spring, but is exposed to rainwater and/or surface water.	Litter or compost is stacked less than 200 feet from the well or spring and is exposed to rainwater and/or surface water.
