# POLAR BEAR



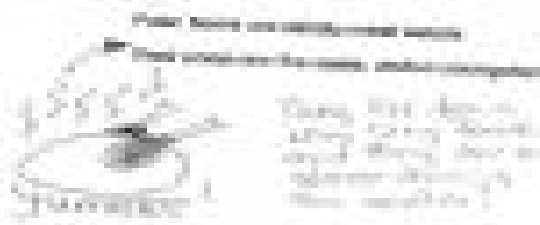
