Present Participle	verb with 'ing' ending, eg <u>running</u> , used with ESTAR in the Present and Past Progressive	Infinitive - ar/er/ir +>	+ ando	+ iendo	+ iendo
Present Progressive	to tell what a person is <u>doing</u> right now, eg. He/ <u>is</u> , they/ <u>are running</u> ... Present Indicative of ESTAR + Present Participle	estoy estás esta	estamos estáis están	- <i>ar</i> + ando	- <i>er/ir</i> + iendo
Past Progressive	to describe action during a given period or specific time in the past; eg. He/ <u>was</u> , they/ <u>were running</u> ... Imperfect of ESTAR + Present Participle	estaba estabas estaba	estábamos estabais estaban	- <i>ar</i> + ando	- <i>er/ir</i> + iendo
