

## **BEHAVIOR MODIFICATION WORKSHEET**

Check the misbehavior that needs modification.

- Late to class
- Failure to bring supplies (textbook, writing utensil, notebook, paper)
- Calling Out
- Talking during lecture
- Talking while another student is answering a question
- Arguing with the teacher
- Sleeping during class or laying their head on the desk
- Use of Inappropriate Language

In paragraph format using 500 words on a separate sheet of paper, type 2 behavior plans that will curb and ultimately end the misbehavior. The student is required to sign the plan in pen and submit it to the teacher by the next class. The paper should also include why this misbehavior is distracting to the other students learning. Use of inappropriate language, failure to acknowledge the misbehavior and its negative effects will result in a failure for the behavior modification plan.

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Failure to fulfill these requirements by the next class will result in a referral slip and will be handled by the school's administration.

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> offenses during the same class on the same misbehavior will result in a referral slip and will be handled by the school's administration in addition to the behavior modification plan worksheet.

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> offense of the same misbehavior during the same class will result in the student being removed from the classroom, in addition to the referral slip as well as a phone call to the parent. It is the student's responsibility to make up work missed during class either after school that day or after school the following day. It is the student's responsibility to contact the teacher to schedule a time to make up any missed work.

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> offense of the same misbehavior over the length of a quarter, the student's parent or guardian will be contacted and the student will write another behavior modification plan to replace the old plan.

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> offense of the same misbehavior over the length of the quarter, the student will receive one point deducted from their quarter grade, in addition to rewriting a behavior modification plan, and their parent or guardian will be contacted.
