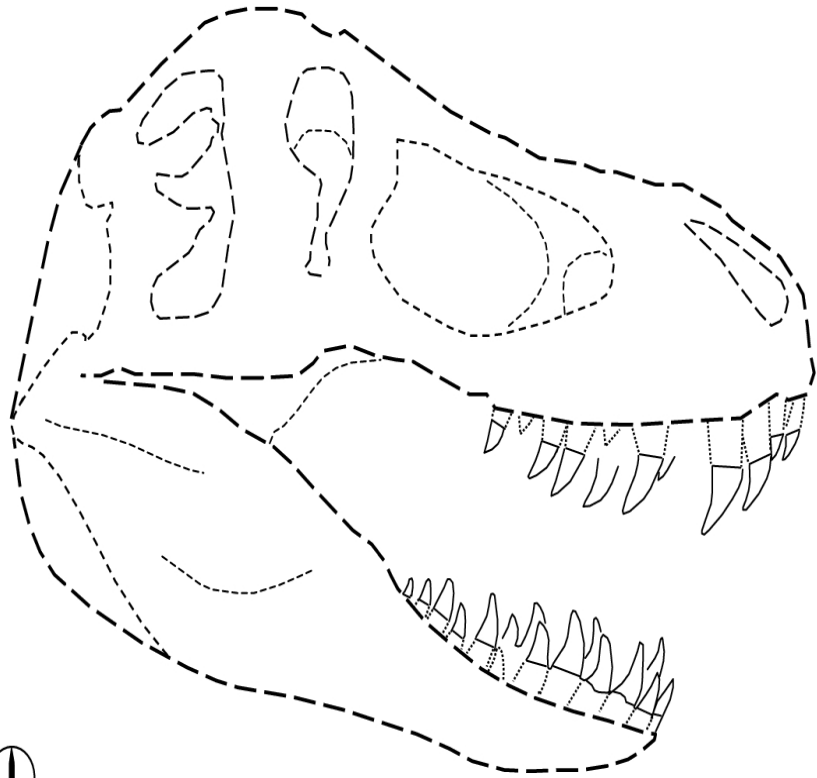
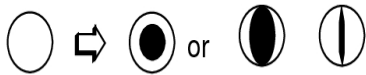


Draw *T. rex* worksheet

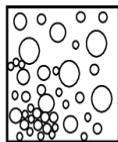

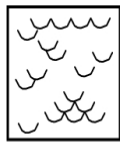
Different types of eyes



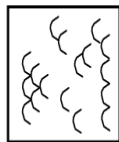
Different types of scale patterns



Circles



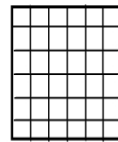
U-shaped



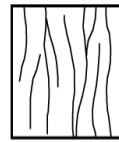
C-shaped
