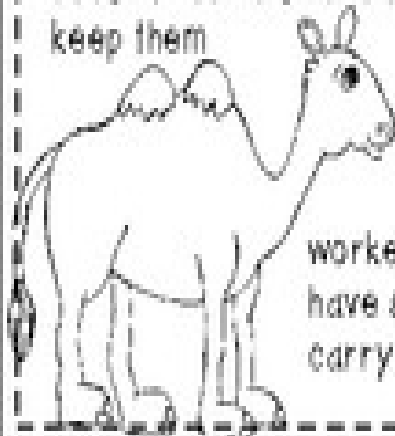


# The Camel
