



#### To play (prepositions only):

**Setup:** Place 1-2 polar bears in the water, and 1-2 on the ice. Deal remaining polar bear cards (land and water). Be sure the "iceberg" is oriented the same way for all players. Preposition cards are shuffled and placed face down in the center of the table. On your turn, select a preposition card and place the polar bear according to the direction.

**Competing:** Deal all polar bear cards (water and land). Preposition cards, plus the four "two-card" cards, are shuffled and placed in the center of the table. On your turn, select a preposition card and place the polar bear according to the direction. "Out of the water," "Off the ice," may put a bear back in your hand. If you drop, "Two-card" take any polar bear from the ice into your hand. The object is to get rid of all your cards.

#### To play (prepositions and pronouns):

**Setup:** Place 1-2 polar bears in the water, and 1-2 on the ice. Deal remaining polar bear cards (land and water). Be sure the "iceberg" is oriented the same way for all players. Preposition cards are shuffled and placed face down in the center of the table. Pronoun cards (either colored or white) are shuffled and placed separately on the table. On your turn, select a pronoun card, then a preposition card and place the polar bear (s) according to the direction.

**Competing:** Deal all polar bear cards (water and land). Preposition cards, plus the four "two-card" cards, are shuffled and placed in the center of the table. On your turn, select a pronoun card and then a preposition card and place the polar bear according to the direction. "Out of the water," "Off the ice," may put a bear back in your hand. If you drop, "Two-card" take any polar bear from the ice into your hand. The object is to get rid of all your cards.
