

EXAMPLE BEHAVIOR PLAN

My Behavior Plan For This Lesson

Behavior (I.E. CCSS): Our behavior/discipline plan focuses on student responsibility. Students will take responsibility for their actions. Students will be rewarded for their good choices and will receive consequences for their poor choices.

Classroom Rules:

1. Work quietly. Do not disturb others who are working.
2. Listen and follow directions.
3. Raise your hand and wait to be called on before speaking.
4. Participate in discussions.
5. Use Body Blocks when seated on the Reading Rug.
6. Keep your hands, feet, & objects to yourself.
7. Walk quietly in the classroom & halls.
8. Follow all school rules.

Rewards:

1. Praise
2. Stickers and high 5's
3. Lucky Lottery tickets
4. Extra privileges
5. Positive note home

If you choose to break a rule:

1. Verbal warning
2. Behavior log & note home (first strike)
3. Behavior log, note home, & loss of privilege (second strike)
4. Behavior log, parent conference, & detention with Mr. [last] (third strike)

Procedures:

1. When needing help:
 - First:
 - o Look to my partners or the student board for help
 - o If those don't help
 - o Ask a neighbor
 - o Finally if you still need assistance:
 - o Ask the teacher or adult available.
2. After completing the primary activity, go to the reading rug and find an alternative activity. Only 2 people per activity and it is FIRST COME FIRST SERVED.
