

Money word problems:

1) Karen wants to buy three apples. Each apple costs 35 cents. She has 75 cents. How much more money does Karen need?

2) Jeffrey has \$4.00 in his piggy bank. He goes to the store and spends \$3.24. How much does he have left in his piggy bank?

3) Gerie wants to buy a toy for \$2.85 and a toy for \$3.27. She needs to know how much money she will need before she goes shopping.

4) Mark wants to go to the movies. A ticket costs \$7 and a snack pack will cost \$4. Mark's parents told him that they will give him 50 cents for each job he does around the house. How many jobs will Mark have to do in order to get all of the money that he needs to go to the movies?

5) Lisa buys ice cream every Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday at school. Ice cream costs one dollar. If she does this for four weeks how much money will she need?
