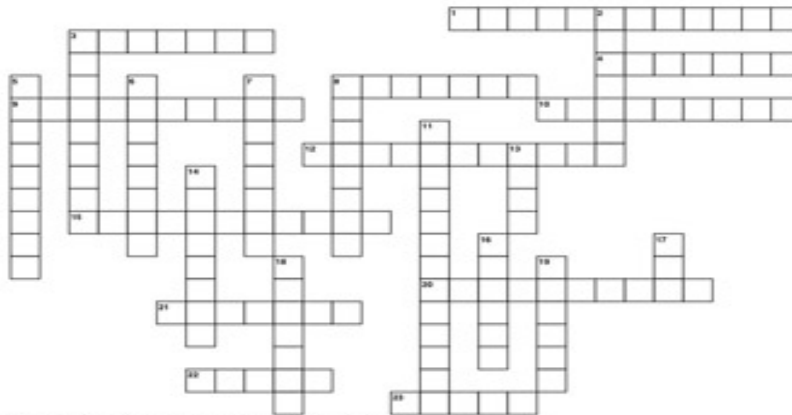




## THE REST OF THE AMENDMENTS (11-27) CROSSWORD PUZZLE
