
Circles

A <u>circle</u> is named by the point in the center.

A $\underline{\text{radius}}$ is a line segment from the center of the circle to the edge.

A $\underline{\text{diameter}}$ is a line segment that passes through the center of a circle. It has two points on the outside edge of the circle.


