Idea Bank

- Our flag has many nicknames.
- People celebrate Flag Day in many ways.

- June 14 is our flag's birthday.



- Our leaders chose an official flag on June 14, 1777.
- Before that, Americans flew different flags.
- The first flag had 13 stripes and 13 stars.

- People display flags on their houses and at work.
- Some schools hold programs that honor the flag.
- There are parades in honor of Flag Day.

- Raise the flag swiftly, but lower it slowly.
- The flag should not touch the ground.
- The flag should be folded into a triangle.

- Some people call the flag Old Glory.
- Other people call it the Red, White, and Blue.
- Another name for the flag is the Stars and Stripes.
