Animals behave in many different ways.

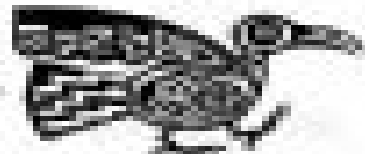
Describe and explain how each of the animals below is different.
