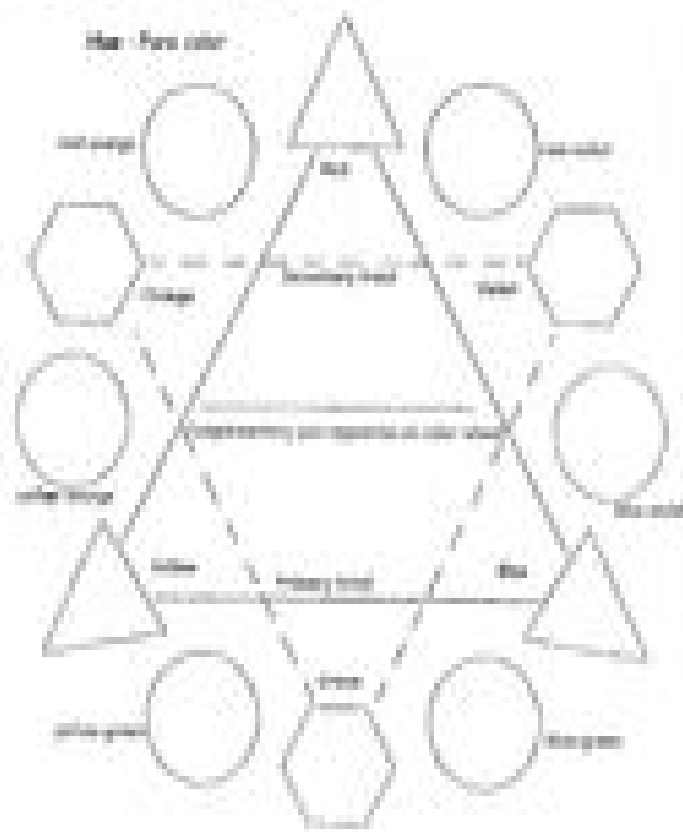


COLOR THEORY



Intensity - The brightness or darkness of a color, also called its saturation.

100%		50-75%		25-50%		0-25%

Value - The lightness or darkness of a color.

Chrominance - Chrominance refers to the amount of color in an image.

Primary Color - Red, Yellow, Blue
These colors cannot be mixed from any other color.

Secondary Color - Orange, Green, Purple
Secondary colors are the equal mixtures of primary colors.

Tertiary Color (Tint) - Tint - any hue produced by primary and secondary colors. (R, Y, B) (RO, YO, BO, etc.)
