

## COMPOUND SENTENCES

### COORDINATED SENTENCES

A compound sentence is formed with:  
Independent Clause + Coordinating Conjunction + Independent

Coordinating Conjunction are: and, but, yet, for, or, so, nor.

For example: John has applied for a scholarship, and a letter requested financial aid.

### SENTENCE CONNECTIONS

A Compound sentence is also Formed with:  
Independent Clause + Sentence Connector + Independent

Examples ( : )

Sentence Connectors are: furthermore, besides, besides, in addition, moreover, also.

For Example: Students must take the final exam; otherwise, they may be given the final of receipts.

## COORDINATORS AND CONNECTORS

Coordinating Conjunctions	Sentence Connectors	Meaning
And	Furthermore, besides, in addition, moreover, also	Additional idea
But, Yet	However, in contrast, nevertheless, still	Contrast idea
For	-	Reason
Or	Otherwise	Choice of two possibilities
So	Consequently, therefore, thus, accordingly	Result
Nor	-	Negative choice
