- Names that end in **ai, ai, ai, ai, ai, ai** form the plural by adding **'s'** (often irregular). Here's an example: **rain -> rains**

- Names that end in **'y'** which are preceded by a consonant form the plural by changing the **'y'** to **'i'** and then adding on **'s'**. Here's an example: **city -> cities**

- Names that end in **'s'** which are preceded by a vowel form the plural by changing the **'s'** to **'es'** and then adding on **'s'**. Here's an example: **fish -> fishes**

- Names that end in **'er'** form the plural by **dropping the 'e'** and then adding onto the **'s'**. Here's an example: **war -> wars**
