

How to Draw a Chinese Dragon Face

Start by drawing lightly so you can erase later.

Draw a large circle for the head and rectangles for the snout and jaw. Use circles for the eyes and nose.

Made the lines flow so there are no straight lines.

Use wavy lines for the mane so the mane looks like fire. Use wavy lines for the eye lashes, and eyebrows.

The whiskers are two wavy lines that meet. There can be one or two spurs on them.



Go over your drawing with a fine tip marker and draw the pencil marks or trace it. Then color your dragon - use a set of red, yellow and orange.



Use triangles for the teeth and a long skinny triangle for the long, sharp, curved back.

Add decorations like horns, scales or circles to fill in the empty spaces.

Give the ear rounded.
