

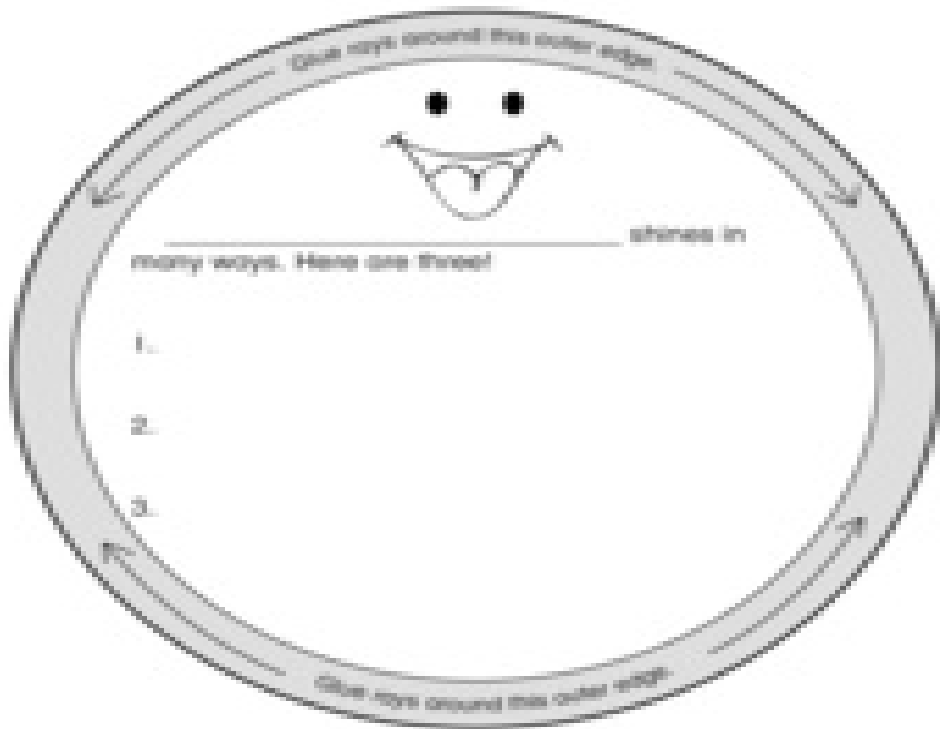
# ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ Family Fun ★ ★ ★ ★ ★
