

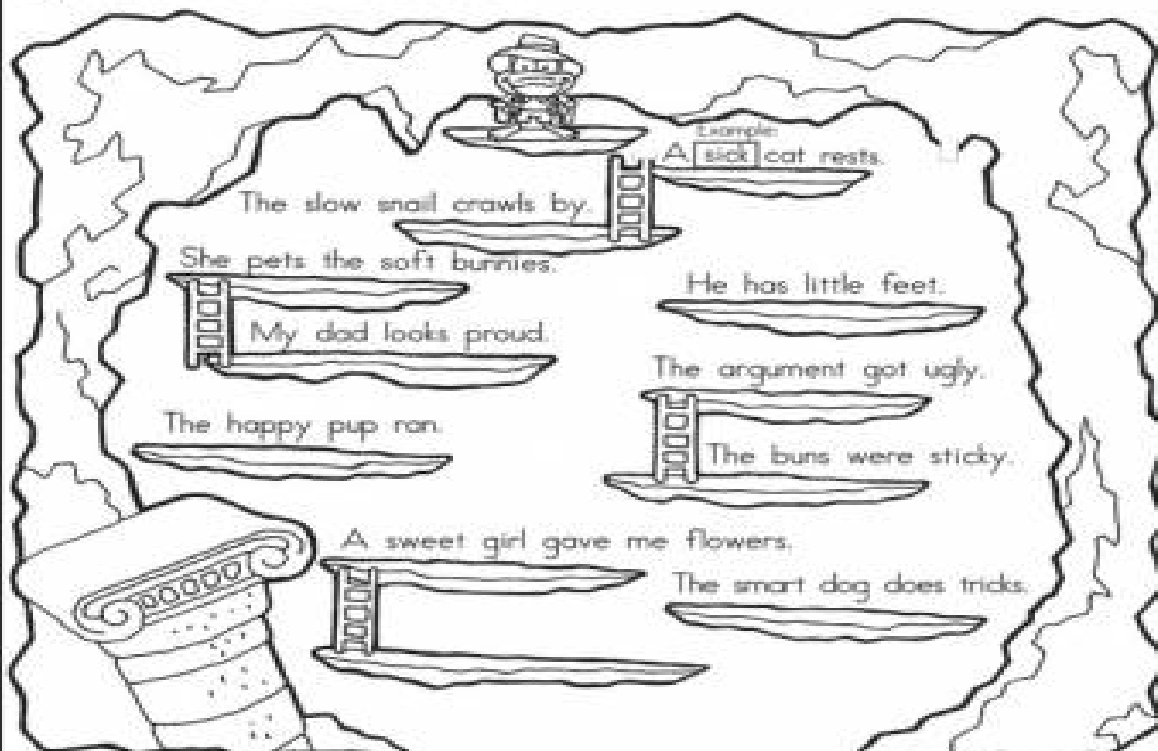

Plant a garden of adjectives with your child. First cut 4 two-inch circles from colored paper. Cut five or six paper ovals for each circle; the ovals will form the petals of each flower. Have your child glue the ovals to the back of each circle. In the center of each flower write a noun, such as cat, baby, bear, or tree. Then have your child write on each petal an adjective that describes the noun in the center. When he has filled in all the petals, tape the flowers to your refrigerator for a colorful display.
