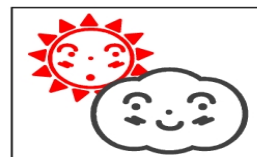




How do I create a climate graph?



Aims

-To create a Bar and Line Graph together on one graph to show different climates around the world. These are called Climate Graphs.

Task 1 -The web site and data

- Go to the site www.worldclimate.com and type in the city name Manaus in the search box. When it comes up click on the city name that is given in blue.
- Now choose Average Rainfall First (It is important to do it in this sequence)
 - Highlight the months and rain in mm only by starting in the top left box
 - Right click and select copy
 - Go to excel and open a spreadsheet
 - Right click to paste but **YOU MUST CLICK IN CELL A1** in the top left
- Return to the internet site and go back to the name of Manaus
 - Click on average temperature in degrees C
 - When this appears, highlight **ONLY °C**, as you already have the months
 - Right click on this one row and select copy
 - Return to the spreadsheet and right click and **paste in cell A3**

Task 2-The spreadsheet

You need to now work in the spreadsheet only

- Change the A2 cell to rainfall in mm and press enter (This is for the key)
- Change the A3 cell to temperature and press enter (This is for the key)
- Highlight all of the three rows but **DO NOT INCLUDE THE YEAR AND THE TOTAL VALUES that are on the right hand side**
- Left click on chart wizard in the top bar and proceed with the next stage

Task 3-The Graph

For this task you are creating the graph

- Select Custom Types for the types of graph
- Choose Line-Column on 2 axes for the type
- Click on next. This will show you what it looks like
- Click on next again and give the chart
 - A title; in this case it is called A Climate graph of Manaus
 - Label Category x axis as Months
 - Label Value Y axis as Rainfall in mm
 - Label 2nd Value Y axis as Temperature in °C
 - Click on next and go to new sheet and call it A Climate Graph of—
 - Click on Finish
 - Adjust labels size by using a left click on the box
 - Create a suitable background colour, a wider line or a different coloured line with a double left click; remember these are functional and informative and not meant to be multi coloured.
 - Select Edit-Copy and open a Word Document and Edit -Paste and Save

Repeat tasks for 2 more cities Khartoum in the Sudan and Churchill, Man, (Manitoba) Canada. Save all. These names are how to recognise them.
