*** HOMEOWNER CLAUSE:** The electrical law provides you, as the homeowner, the opportunity to perform your own wiring provided the following conditions are true: (1) you are the property owner and this property is not for sale or resale, is not rental property which is occupied or is to be occupied by tenants for lodging, either transient or permanent; and is not generally open to the public; (2) the wiring will be inspected prior to covering, i.e., insulation, drywall, etc., and again upon completion of the system prior to occupancy and permanent power release; and (3) all electrical work will be done in accordance with the National Electrical Code adopted by the Colorado State Electrical Board.
