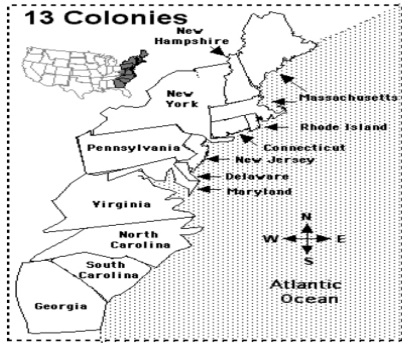


# 13 Colonies Map
