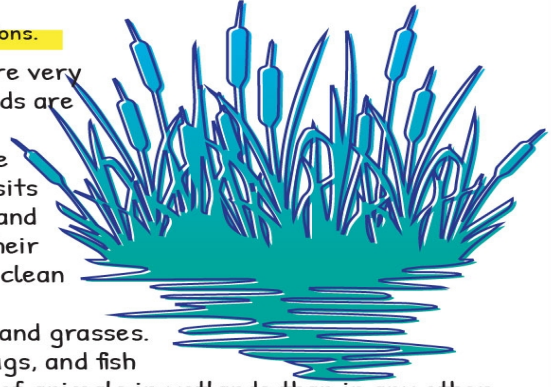
WETLANDS
