

1 Point Perspective: Cubes

This exercise explains how to draw a cube in one-point perspective and leads you through the steps of drawing three cubes, making them all additional steps, before you all end with the horizon line.

KEY POINTS

- Draw the horizon line and draw as if you are looking up at them (you see the bottom of the object)
- Draw below the horizon line and draw as if you are looking down at them (you see the top of the object)
- Draw the line in line with the horizon line and draw as if they are all the same (you see the top or the bottom of the object)
