First published 4 July 1776

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.

endowed: to believe, to consider
truths: (noun) something that is true
self-evident: (adjective) obvious, clear, obvious without need of proof
created: (verb) to bring into being, to create
unalienable: (adjective) the same when sold and
endowed: (verb) to provide with, provided, gifted
creator: (noun) a person or machine or nature that creates something
rights: (noun) a freedom, a liberty, a law
unalienable: (adjective) untransferable, cannot be given to another person
right: (noun) a power or privilege that a person has by law or tradition
liberty: (noun) freedom
pursuit: (noun) an activity that a person wants to follow, to do
