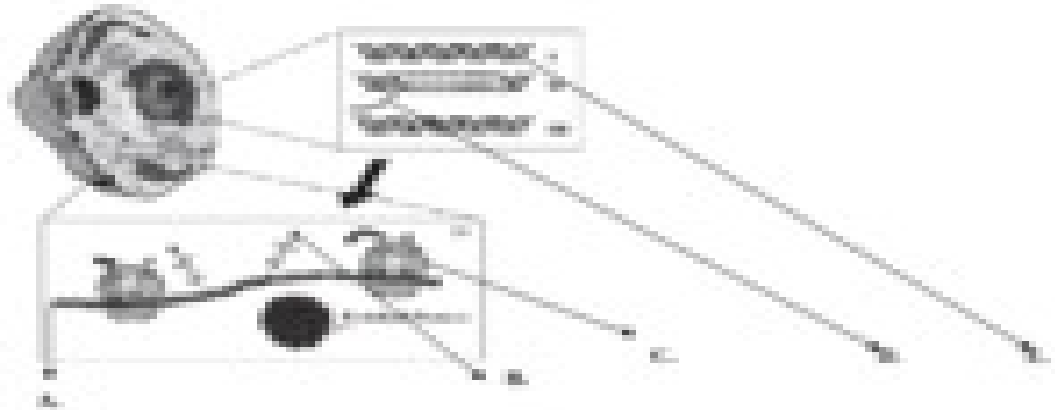


PROBLEMS AND ANSWERS (continued)

PROB 1. Read the following and take notes on your paper:

Protein synthesis in the prokaryotic cell by the body to make proteins. The first step of protein synthesis is called transcription. It occurs in the nucleus. During transcription, mRNA messenger ribonucleic acid, which is "messed" and the mRNA messenger is made of DNA. There is also the mRNA. Some the mRNA will go into the cytoplasm. mRNA will then start itself to self-replicate. The second of mRNA is then used to make a protein. They are made 1 hour at a time. These have an exact order. mRNA is the building block. It brings the amino acids to the ribosome to help make the protein. The 3 bases of mRNA are called codons. However, amino acids are the building block for proteins. On the mRNA strand, there are two amino acid codons. These help know where to start and stop building a protein. Another when we read a sentence, we know when to start reading by the capital letter and when to stop by the period.
