

Story Outline Rubric

An excellent piece will meet all of the following criteria:

- A. Completeness
 - 1. Student answers all questions in each section.
 - 2. Student provides sufficiently detailed responses.

- B. Quality of Details
 - 1. Student creates realistic, interesting, compelling characters
 - 2. Student connects the setting to the main character's life and conflict.
 - 3. Student lists the events of the story in a clear, sequential order that shows how one event leads to another.
 - 4. Student provides links between the main character's actions and the effects of those actions.

- C. Relation to Article
 - 1. Student uses details from the article to create the main character.
 - 2. Student integrates the events of the article with their conflict.
 - 3. Student bases the setting of their story outline on the setting stated or implied in the article.
