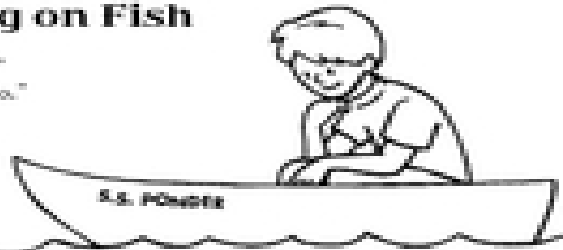


Focusing on Fish
