

Superlative Adjectives

A. Use

Use superlative adjectives to compare more than two people, places, or things.

B. Form

Number of Syllables	Form	Example
one	the + Adj + -est	the + tall + -est = the tallest
two (ending in -y)	the + Adj (-y changes to -i) + -est	the + happy + -est = the happiest
two (not ending in -y)	the + most + Adj	the + most + famous = the most famous
three (or more)	the + most + Adj	the + most + beautiful = the most beautiful

C. Examples

- John is **the tallest** boy in the class.
- Out of all of my classmates, Christina is **the happiest**. She's always smiling!
- I think Brad Pitt is **the most famous** actor in Hollywood.
- Her last painting is the most beautiful one she's ever done.
