1. The population of Uganda is 32.4 million. If 63.1% of these people do not have access to safe drinking water, how many people is that in total?
2. According to an aid agency it costs \$0.95 a day to provide a child in Zimbabwe with an education, food, and safe drinking water. How much would it cost to support this child for 1 month (assuming this month had 30 days)?
3. If your class wanted to support 5 children in Zimbabwe, how much money would we have to spend every month?
4. There are 0.4 billion children in Africa. Write this number in standard form.
5. There are 73.7 million children in the United States. 1 in 4 of these children live in poverty. How many children is that?
